Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire

Delivered together with your Crier is a questionnaire - **Lound Neighbourhood Plan**.

What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan can set out a vision for an area and contain planning policies for the use and development of land. It is structured to help guide development, rather than to prevent it. *Example:* it could cover where new homes, offices, buildings etc. should be built, what they should look like, which open green spaces and local amenities should be protected.

How do we do this?

The Parish Council has to establish a Committee (Neighbourhood Planning Team) to prepare the plan. When it is completed and has been passed by an independent examiner, and if adopted, the Plan will become a legal document. This Plan will then have to be used by Bassetlaw Planning Committee when determining planning applications in and around our village.

It is therefore very important to participate and have your say by completing the Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire. If interested in the development in Lound then you can help by getting involved.

You will have recently received a form which tells you who is currently registered at your address. This is not a registration document but you do need to respond to the form, even if there are no changes to the details (your form and leaflet will tell you how). The information you provide will enable Bassetlaw to send a separate individual form to all the people in your household who are eligible and need to register. If you have not responded then you will receive another form for completion. If again not completed, a follow-up visit may result.

Important: If you are not on the register you might be refused a loan, mobile phone contract or even be turned down for a bank account.
