

# **Devolution - Have Your Say**

Bassetlaw Residents are being asked for their views on a devolution deal that could allow for powers and decisions on millions of pounds worth of funding to be made locally, instead of by Government officials in London.

Following a decision by Councillors in March, Bassetlaw District Council has applied to be a full member of the Sheffield City Region (SCR), which has already negotiated a deal with the Government to make local decisions on how £900 million in funding over the next 30 years is spent, in addition to an additional £484 million over the next five years.

This funding would be used to create jobs, invest in housing, and create training opportunities for local people. But before this can be approved by Government, the SCR and the Council must first consult with residents.
