The church began around 1160, though much of what we see today dates to the 14th and 15th centuries. Taking a closer look will reveal a hole in the spire marking the spot where the shot from a Parliamentarian cannon is said to have struck the church in 1664 during the Civil War

The visit will include a private tour of the church commencing at 4.00pm with tea and coffee on arrival. The cost each will be around £4.50 depending on numbers. On return home, a meal has been arranged at Spencer's, Retford at £12.50 for a two course meal.
