Progress So Far

Stage 1

- Parish Council initiate Process
- Apply to Bassetlaw District Council to inform them we are producing a plan
- Define Neighbourhood Area
- Establish a committee

Progress So Far

Stage 2

- Consult with the village and local businesses and other stakeholders
- Questionnaires
- Produce a report on the questionnaires

We are here now

Next Steps

- Some of the results show a majority want some development, although the results are not consistent. Over half (57%) of the answers to one question wanted no new housing but of those that answered the question 'How many dwellings would you like to see'
- 130 wanted none (40%)
- 191 wanted some dwellings (60%)
- (Another 39 people didn't answer.)

Next Steps

- Identify more accurately where the village would like to develop, in one or more favoured sites
- Approach landowners to gauge their interest
- Write Draft Plan
- Aims and objectives of the plan are defined by the consultation and by national and local guidance.

Further down the line

Stage 3

- The Plan is checked by an independent assessor
- Plan is: accepted
 modified
 rejected

Further consultation might be needed if the plan is substantially modified

Referendum

Stage 4

- Once Bassetlaw District Council has accepted the plan we have a Community Referendum.
- 50% of the people voting on the day have to accept it.
- Once the plan is accepted it is adopted by the Council.
