On **Tuesday June 20th** a visit has been arranged to Epworth Old Rectory. The Rectory is a Grade 1 listed building built in 1709 and was the home of the 10 children of the Wesley Family.

Charles Wesley, born 18th December 1707, developed the Methodist Movement. There will be an hour long walk around Epworth on the Wesley Trail, (cost £6), the tour of the house lasts one and a half hours (cost £6), there is a small Psychic garden to investigate and then afternoon tea (cost £5 per person).


Missing Play Equipment-
