

Hanoverian Lound—Final

A century of Lound's History is lost

There were 91 dwellings and a population of 438 chiefly engaged in agriculture. Hop plantations were dying out, but abundant crops of early potatoes were being grown for the Sheffield market. Bell Moor, a farm of some 700 acres of land, mostly in Lound, was the property of Col. William Markham and Highfield was the seat of the Dowager Lady Galway. 'Mattersey, Sutton and Barnby Moor' formed, we are told, 'a genteel neighborhood'.

In 1834, a Wesleyan chapel was built, but the village had to wait until 1859 for a church to replace that lost three centuries earlier. In 1884 three detached portions of Sutton were amalgamated into Lound which lost an outlying part of Sutton, and by 1901 the population had fallen to 334. In 1941, the Portland estate here was comprised in the sale of 10,000 acres in Nottinghamshire to the Duke of Devonshire, but the transaction did nothing to disturb existing tenancies: it was simply a change from one ducal owner to another.

Lound Neighbourhood Plan



The result of the Referendum held on 24th February 2022, in response to the question "Do you want Bassetlaw District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Lound to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?", is as follows:

Votes	Number
Yes	143
No	47
Total	190

As more than half of those voting have voted in favour of the Plan it is now "made" and its provisions come into effect immediately as part of the District Planning Process.

The full Declaration can be seen on the Lound Village website.

The number of votes cast represents 48% of the total number of 394 persons entitled to vote in the Referendum.

This is a very good turnout for a Neighbourhood Plan Referendum and the Steering Group would like to thank the villagers for all their support throughout a long process.
