We are all very pleased with the garden progress so far. We get very reassuring comments from villagers on how good the garden looks, weeds and all. Controlling the weeds that we do not want and limiting the wild flowers that want to take over is a fine balance.

I have carried out all the grass cutting on the garden this year apart from the first cut. This is necessary to control what gets cut and when. The very high level of moss on the site is now under control. A Bosch battery strimmer has been purchased to aid controlling the grass around the plantings. The newly planted plants and shrubs are growing very well and the Christmas tree has never looked better with its regular soaking from the hose pipe.

During the summer general maintenance will take place until autumn / winter when there will be another push with development. For example; fence repairs and developing a wet area.
