Village Garden



Like everyone else's garden the Village Garden has been suffer-

ing from the lack of water. The soil is sandy and free draining, therefore, even with mulching many of the newer plantings to protect them, if there is no water in the ground it has little effect until some continuous rain falls.

Any sudden rain storm will have little influence as it will run off onto the paths and out of the gates onto the road and away. Some of the newer trees and bushes have been watered using the hosepipe. These include the Christmas tree,

proudly showing off its many cones this year, and the new Liquid Amber tree in the centre front of the garden. The two specialist Buddleia most certainly do not like the lack of water. Hopefully, they may improve when they become more established. Even three heathers are struggling and trying to die on us!

The wild flower bed was short lived but we will try again next year along with a larger display of English bluebells and more snow drops.

On the playing field, the six new trees planted last winter have needed large volumes of water to keep them going. My estimate is that just over 2000 litres have been applied by David George and myself over many months.

Finally, if anyone has any natural stone they would like to donate to the Village Garden it would be very welcome to aid water retention in areas of the soil.
