

Did you know?

Sherwood is a royal forest. Its peculiar fame arises from its historic association with the legend of Robin Hood.

The area has been wooded since the end of the Last Glacial Period. Today, Sherwood Forest National Nature serve encompasses 424.75 hectares (1,049.6 acres), surrounding the village of Edwinstowe and Thoresby Hall Estate. It is a remnant of an older and much larger royal hunting forest, which derived its name from its status as the *shire* (or *sher*) wood of Nottinghamshire, which extended into several neighbouring counties, bordered on the west by the River Erewash and the Forest of East Derbyshire.
