#### Lound Village Archive—Part 1

The very extensive Lound Village Archive is located in the Old Reading Room. The material in there is for the perusal of villagers who may borrow items by booking them out using the forms found in the drawers.

I have created a list of about 150 significant events that have occurred in the village from documents in the Archive. There will be many more, so I have taken just a few as some examples of what happened and when.

In the 1930's electricity was first brought to Lound Village.

In 1934 the Wesleyan Chapel was purchased for £90 to make the Village Hall and mainly paid for by the Huntsman family. During the last war an air raid precautions hut was situated on the grass next to the Village Green. Also, in the field behind the Care Home an Army Camp with search light and a gun emplacement were situated. In 1952 the playing field was donated to the village by Col. Kenneth Lee from White Lodge. The playing field extension was then donated to the village by Stephen Toulson from The Limes, across the road from the field.

The Council Houses were built on Chainbridge Road in 1955. This was owned by the council before hand as a corporation farm. The four Council houses on Town Street were built in the 1930's.

In 1961 the Butcher's shop in Bellmoor Cottage was for sale but probably never sold as a shop. We have no more information on that one. If you have more information please let me know.

The old School between Lound and Sutton closed in 1970.

The avenue of trees on Daneshill Road was planted in 1973. Many of them are Maple but also includes other species.


