#### **County Council:**

- The devolution has been formally signed off and mayoral elections will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> May.
- The STEP project is progressing with BDC granting permission for several buildings on site.
- NCC have received further documents and plans from HIVE which will be subject to further consultation shortly.
- The planning Inspectorate has now set the date for the public hearing for the FCC planning appeal which will run 19<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> March / 30<sup>th</sup> April - 3<sup>rd</sup> May and is being held at the Ye Olde Bell Barnby Moor.
- The budget will be signed off at the next council meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> February, it is expected that a balance budget will be set.
